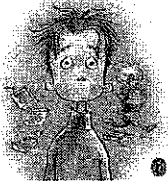


Welcome to 4th Grade!

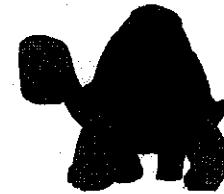

| <p>Choose three character traits to describe Peter. Make sure to use text evidence to support the traits you have chosen. Consider his thoughts, feelings, actions, and his words.</p> | <p>Create comic book panels for the events that took place during Fudge's birthday party.</p> | <p>Compare and contrast Peter and Sheila. Use a venn diagram to organize your thinking. Then, write two paragraphs explaining their similarities and differences.</p> |
| <p>Write a script for your favorite scene/chapter of <i>Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing</i>. With a small group of classmates, act out the scene for your class.</p> | <p>Create a Quote Quilt. Fold your paper in half once, then fold it again. You should now have a paper with 4 rectangles on it. In each section, write an important quote from the novel. On the back, explain the importance of the quotes you have chosen.</p> | <p>Create an acrostic poem using the word, "Peter".</p> |
| <p>Create a book jacket for the novel. On the front, design a new cover. On the back, include a short summary and book review.</p> | <p>Research turtles. Create a Prezi, PowerPoint, Google Slides, or iMovie presentation. Include at least 5 informational facts and pictures.</p> | <p>Find five examples of figurative language in the novel. Identify the type and explain what each example means. You can present your information in a booklet or foldable.</p> |
