

Nonfiction/Historical Fiction Book Report

Imagine I have not read your books. Your project should be able to tell/show me about your book

Supplies Needed

- A hanger
- Ribbon, string, or thick thread
- Hole punch or scissors (for attaching the string)
- Notecards or card stock
- Art supplies: markers, crayons, glitter, etc.

Book Report Project

- Read a chapter book at your grade level.
- Take notes as you read on theme, setting, plot, and characters.
- Create a book mobile.
- Share your mobile with the class.

Mobile Requirements

- First string on mobile: Illustrate and describe 2-3 characters. On each index card or piece of construction paper, illustrate and describe each character.
- Second string on mobile: Create three index cards/construction paper of a summary of the beginning, middle, and end of the book. On the fourth index card/construction paper, explain either a theme of the story, or the conflict and solution (depending on your story, if there is both a theme and conflict/solution, DO BOTH).
- Third string on mobile: Draw a picture of the setting and explain why this setting is significant in the story. If there is more than one setting, make multiple settings.
- On top of the hanger: Write the title, author, and your name in the middle of the project.
